Agreement

An agreement between the Sponsor and St Joseph's College Toowoomba (hereinafter called "SJC"), whereby it is agreed

1. In consideration of the agreement the sponsor is to pay SJC the sum of money determined by the agreed sponsorship level to sponsor the 2025 Confraternity and QISSN Programs.
2. Both parties agree to the terms of the sponsorship as listed in this document.
3. Payment of the said sum, shall be made in full upon receiving the invoice from SJC. SJC will issue a receipt upon payment being received.
